Details:

Turn hollow forms without hollowing through a small opening and learn surface embellishing techniques. In this class students will first learn techniques that allow you to cut a piece in half, hollow each half and then glue the halves back together, using green wood. This eliminates the challenge of hollowing a piece through a small opening. The second half of the class will cover many of the surface embellishing techniques that I've used over the years, including power carving, engraving, wire brushing, dying and painting using milk paints. Students should have some basic turning experience and be comfortable using and sharpening a bowl gouge.
